“Viewing the Form of Family Interactions”

Lee “Bob” Smith, LMFT, IFCS Director of Training and Development, presented at the 2007 National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI of Maryland) conference.

NAMI of Maryland is a grassroots organization dedicated to education, support and advocacy for persons with mental illnesses, their families and the wider community. Their mission is to improve the quality of life for individuals with severe mental illnesses and their families.

Mr. Smith presented a PowerPoint entitled: “Viewing the Form of Family Interactions”. Since bringing an entire family together can sometimes be overwhelming and intimidating, Mr. Smith’s workshop discussed how to conduct a session that will help make the session productive and easier to manage. He also shared how to initiate a family session: tips, tricks and traps were reviewed. Techniques were also described and role plays were included with coaching.
